

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Associate Degree Programs

To be eligible to graduate from an associate degree program, students must fulfill the following graduation requirements:

- Completion of all program requirements within seven years of admittance to St. Catherine University
- Completion of LIFE core requirements (<http://catalog.stkate.edu/undergraduate/core-curriculum/liberal-arts-science-core-curriculum-associate-programs/>)
- Completion of the residency requirement of 30 semester credits in residence
- Completion of all professional courses within five years of beginning the sequence
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0
- Completion of a Graduation Application form

Certificates

- Completion of certificate requirements
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0

Baccalaureate Degree Requirement for Students Enrolling or Re-Enrolling at St. Catherine University Fall 2022 or Later ¹

Candidates for a B.A., B.S., or B.S.N.² degree must fulfill the following graduation requirements:

- A minimum of 120 semester credits including:
 - completion of the LIFE core curriculum³
 - acceptance into and completion of the requirements for an approved major
- Completion of the residency requirement of 32 semester credits in residence (this applies to students seeking their *first or second* bachelor's degree)
- Completion of a minimum of 36 upper-division (3000- or 4000-level) credits
- Completion of a Graduation Application form
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0

¹ Students who enrolled prior to fall 2022 are advised to reference the requirements of the catalog applicable to their term of enrollment.

² Candidates for a B.S.N. degree enrolled in the RN-BSN Degree Completion section are required to complete a minimum of 30 semester credits in residence. This requirement is reduced to 26 semester credits for RN-BSN students who have completed a previous baccalaureate degree.
